 Violation #11 Boys and Girls gang bathrooms- Provide soap and paper towels.
Code Reference FAC: Cleanliness & Repair 64E-13.004(6)(a). Walls to a height of at least 4' feet toilet partitions and floor of all toilet rooms shall be finished with impervious materials. All plumbing fixtures shall conform to the provisions of the local plumbing code. All group toilet rooms shall be provided with at least one (1) floor drain and (1) hose bib. The floor shall be sloped to the drain. Deodorizers shall not be used in toilet rooms.

Violation #23 Rm 11- Eliminate old roach droppings and eggs from cabinets (cited previously).
Code Reference FAC: Infestation/Control 64E-13.004(10). Effective measures shall be used to prevent harborage, propagation, or infestations of rodents and all insects.
