Dear Parent/Guardian:

The International Education Program at Air Base Elementary School has an advanced academic curriculum, which combines interdisciplinary course work with intensive language and cultural studies. The criteria for continuation in the International Education Magnet Program is an average of “C” in each academic subject, foreign language and in conduct. In addition, an excess of 10 or more tardies and absences can affect status in the program.

Student progress will be monitored each grading period to ensure that required criteria is being met and maintained. **Students having difficulty will be placed on probation for a period of 9 weeks.** During that time students are expected to meet and maintain the minimum requirements of the program. If improvement is not shown by the end of the probationary period, the student’s academic standing will be reviewed to decide if the child should continue the International Education Program or explore other options.
